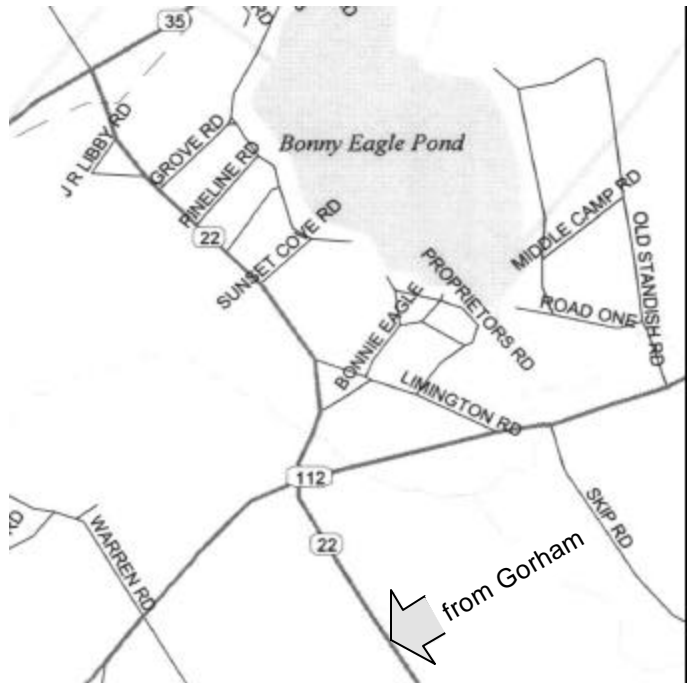

## Recipe of the Month Caribbean Chicken

- 2 tbsp vegetable oil
- 1 lb boned and skinned chicken parts
- 1 lg onion, sliced (about 1 cup)
- 2 lg tomatoes, chopped (about 1 cup each)
- 2 tbsp soy sauce
- ¼ cup water
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1/8 tsp pepper
- 2 tsp curry powder
- 1 tbsp parsley flakes

Heat oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium heat. Add chicken and brown lightly on all sides, turning frequently. Reduce heat to low. Add remaining ingredients, mixing well. Cover and cook 1 hour, stirring occasionally. (Add small amounts of water, if necessary, to prevent drying) Serves 4. This recipe is great over rice, and I add more curry.
